



COMMUNITY EMERGENCY FUNDING GRANT

Emergency Funding up to \$1,000

Funding available until August 31, 2020.
Funding approvals within 2 business days.

The Community Emergency Fund offers one-time financial assistance to individuals and families experiencing financial hardship or poverty, and facing an emergency need.

Emergency needs may include:

- Rental Assistance (Rent payment or damage deposit)
- Utilities
- Food
- Other supports

Funding will be granted if all other supports for emergency assistance have been exhausted. Funding is typically paid to a third party.

How to Apply:

1. An individual must nominate the recipient for Emergency Funding. Individuals must be connected to the recipient professionally (ie: teacher, social worker, community worker, religious leader, etc.)
2. Individual must complete the "Funding Application Form" or submit a letter on official letterhead outlining the nature of the need, and the amount requested.
3. Submit completed referrals to communitygrant@e4calberta.org

***Note: Self-referrals and referrals from family members will not be accepted.
Application submissions do not guarantee funding.***
